

WIPMC Leveraged Funds

Funds Leveraged through Western Integrated Pest Management Center Competitive Grants

Competitive grants provided through the Western IPM Center yield data and results that have then been used in acquiring additional funding for the advancement of IPM in production agriculture; residential, urban, and institutional settings; research and extension programs; natural resource and wildland spaces; and public areas throughout the United States. Since 2004, Western IPM Center funding has resulted in more than **\$16.7 million** in leveraged funds, representing an overall return of **\$10 for each \$1 awarded**.

Work Groups

Leveraged funds resulting from WIPMC-funded work groups have totaled more than **\$6.6 million** via the Western Sustainable Agriculture Research and Education program (WSARE), the Southwest Consortium on Plant Genetics and Water Resources, the National Plant Diagnostic Network (NPDN), the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Mini Grant Program, the Arizona Department of Agriculture's Specialty Crop block grant and Field Demonstrations Reduced Risk Pesticide Use grant, the California Department of Food and Agriculture Specialty Crop block grant program, USEPA's Pesticide Registration Improvement Renewal Act (PRIA 2) program and Pesticide Environmental Stewardship Program, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 10, USDA's National Resources Conservation Service, the Oregon Association of Nurseries, the Oregon Department of Agriculture, the Oregon Wine Board, WIPMC's Addressing Western IPM Issues program, IR-4, and USDA-NIFA's



Pest Management Alternatives Program, National Research Initiative, Extension IPM program, Specialty Crop Research Initiatives program, National Extension Integrated Pest Management Special Projects program, Agriculture and Food Research Initiative program, Regional IPM Program (Western Region), and Risk Avoidance and Mitigation Program.



Rate of Return: \$22 for every \$1 awarded.

Special Projects

WIPMC funding in the Special Projects grants program has leveraged more than **\$792,000** through USEPA Regions 8 and 10, the Arizona Department of Agriculture, the Washington Specialty Crop Block Grant program, WIPMC's Addressing Western IPM Issues program, USDA-NIFA's Regional IPM Program (Western Region), the USDA Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), the National Science Foundation, and the U.S. Forest Service.

Rate of Return: \$14 for every \$1 awarded.



Addressing Western IPM Issues

Funding leveraged through WIPMC-funded "Addressing Western IPM Issues" grants has totaled more than **\$7.2 million** through the Western Sustainable Agriculture Research

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and Education program (WSARE), the California Department of Pesticide Regulation's Pest Management Alliance Grant program, the Idaho Potato Commission, the Arizona Specialty Crop Block Grant Program, the Bullitt Foundation, private industry support, the Montana Department of Agriculture's Montana Noxious Weed Trust Fund and Montana Alfalfa Seed Committee, Tessenderlo Kerley, Inc. (TKI) NovaSource, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Region 8, the U.S. Forest Service, USDA-Agricultural Research Service State Partnership Potato Program and Specialty Crops Research Initiative, USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service, the Walnut Marketing Board, and USDA-NIFA's Risk Avoidance and Mitigation Program, Pest Management Alternatives Program, Regional IPM Program (Western Region), National Research Initiative, Specialty Crops Research Initiative, and Critical Issues: Emerging and New Plant and Animal Pests and Diseases Program.

Rate of Return: \$8 for every \$1 awarded.

PMSPs and Crop Profiles funded by the WIPMC have yielded more than **\$2 million** in leveraged funding through WIPMC's Addressing Western IPM Issues program, the Oregon Raspberry and Blackberry Commission, and the USDA-National Institute of Food and Agriculture

(USDA-NIFA) Crops at Risk program and Regional IPM Program (Western Region).

Rate of Return: \$5 for every \$1 awarded.
